Based upon the information obtained from your application and the interview process, the evaluator has found you to be “Ineligible” for ADA Paratransit service at this time. However, you are not prevented from riding the fixed-route bus service. This decision was based on one or more of the following criteria:

- You stated that you are able to use the fixed-route service, Mountain Metropolitan Transit, all of the time.
- It is not impossible for you to use the fixed-route service, just inconvenient.
- You do not meet any of the three categories for ADA Paratransit eligibility (Explain below).

Mountain Metropolitan Transit offers a special reduced half price fare for people with disabilities and senior (60 years or older) who ride the fixed-route bus. Show your Medicaid card and your ID card to any driver for reduced fare. Another option is to obtain a disability card from the Independence Center, located at 729 S. Tejon St. When applying for the disability card with the Independence Center, please provide proof of disability.
