# **General Event**

When is the event?

Saturday, June 15, 2024, 8 AM - 2 PM

Where is the event?

Westside Community Center - 1628 West Bijou Street, Colorado Springs, CO 80904

Who can attend this Westside community event?

Anyone can attend!

Do I need tickets; is there a cost to attend?

No, this event is free to attend! Please note if you wish to be a yard sale vendor you will need to register for a vendor space. Register early; there is limited space.

Is this an indoor or outdoor event? What happens if there is bad weather?

Both! The event is rain or shine.

Is this a dog friendly event?

Well-behaved, leashed dogs are welcome to the outdoor portion of the event.

#### Where is parking?

There are free on-street parking spaces surrounding the community center property as well as a small, paved lot off 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Parking is limited and will overflow into the neighborhood. Please be considerate of our neighbors.

#### Why should I register to be a yard sale vendor?

A community-wide yard sale attracts more attention than a solo yard sale. There will be various activities onsite to bring out a diverse crowd of attendees. The event is free to attend and includes local musical acts. The event is being marketed by the City of Colorado Springs; Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services Department; Westside Community Center; Old Colorado City; and local musicians and food trucks.

# **Yard Sale**

### What time is the yard sale?

8 AM – 2 PM. Set up may begin at 7 AM. Yard sale vendors are required to be set up by 7:45 AM and stay until the end of the event at 2 PM.

### What items can be sold at the yard sale?

We are looking for a wide variety of household and recreational goods. The sale of weapons, alcohol, drugs, and drug paraphernalia is strictly prohibited.

### Can I sell my crafts/handmade goods as a yard sale vendor?

Please, no "craft fair" or farmer's market items. Think traditional yard sale.

### Is there a fee to be a yard sale vendor?

Yes, \$20.00 per vendor space. This cost goes towards supporting future community-wide events at the Westside Community Center.

## Is there a deadline to register as a yard sale vendor?

Yes, there are limited vendor spaces available, and vendors must register by Friday, June 7.

### How do I become a yard sale vendor?

You can drop by the Westside Community Center front office or register online here.

### Where will the yard sale take place?

The yard sale component of this event will take place in the gravel lot on the Westside Community Center campus.

### What size is a vendor space?

Vendors will set up behind their vehicle. Each vendor will have a 20' x 20' footprint for their vehicle and vendor space.

## What should I bring other than my items for sale?

Cash to make change, tables, chairs, pop-up/shade tent, sunscreen, water, snacks, etc. Vendors must be self-sufficient and supply all materials to operate your individual yard sale transactions.

# **Swap Meet**

### What is a swap meet?

It is a gathering of people who trade or exchange items for no money.

#### What swap items are accepted?

- Pest-free indoor and outdoor potted plants (mature or cuttings)
- Planter pots
- Books of any genre (paperback and hardback accepted)
- Garden seeds (must be labeled)
- Recipes (bring your favorite recipes on notecards)

#### Where is the swap meet taking place?

In Hughes Hall, inside the main community center building – 1628 West Bijou St.

- Printer cartridges
